

California Consumer Privacy Act Disclosure Form

The California Consumer Privacy Act ("CCPA") creates privacy rights relating to the collection, sale, disclosure, and deletion of consumers' personal information. The CCPA requires businesses to provide consumers, including job applicants, employees, contractors, temporary employees, directors and shareholders with information about their rights, including a description of the categories of personal information to be collected and the purpose for which the information will be used. This Disclosure Form is intended to advise you of this information.

What Information Is Collected? Community Bank of the Bay ("the Bank") will collect the following categories of personal information from you:

Identifying Information	This includes your name, address, telephone number, and social security number.

Timecard & Payroll Data	This includes time worked and identifying
	information for purposes of determining
For employees, contractors, temporary	compensation.

	Examples: attendance and absence records,
	pay history, rest breaks/lunches, hours
	worked.
Credit Card Information	This information may be collected in connection
	with employee expense reports.



For employees and directors	
Leave-Related Documentation	This includes paperwork related to protected
	leaves of absence under the FMLA/CFRA, leaves
For employees	resulting from Workers' Compensation claims, or
	use of sick leave, vacation time, or paid/unpaid
	time off.
Employee Benefit Plan Information	This includes identifying information maintained
	for the administration of the Company's health,
For employees and directors	dental, vision, and disability plans.
	Examples: family members covered under plans,
	benefit selections, beneficiaries, amount of
	life/AD&D insurance.
Employee Activity	This may include your browsing/search history
	and geolocation data associated with your use of
For employees, contractors, temporary	a Company device or BYOD.

	Examples: Telephone, email, IM, text messages.
